Introduction

URS were commissioned by Armagh City & District Council to conduct a feasibility study for the development of Ulster Canal Linear Developments Project.

Key partners in this project are SOAR, SWARD and Cavan & Monaghan Leader which are three of the Clusters in Northern Ireland and Republic of Ireland in implementing /delivering Axis 3 of the Northern Ireland Rural Development Programme (2007-2013) which aims to improve the quality of life in rural areas and encourage diversification of economic activity.

Based on this context the study will consist of at least one development in each of the three LAG areas. Depending on the site characteristics they would include:

- The creation of a focal/access point adjacent to the canal;
- Towpath;
- Facilities for activities;
- Physical links with local community/village/settlement promotion of festivals and events linked to canal theme.

The aims of this study are covered in the next section entitled 'Terms of Reference'



Terms of Reference

The following specified work items comprised the Terms of Reference:

- 1. Identify at least one location in each of the three LAG areas for canal development
- 2. Identify the most appropriate type of development for each location
- 3. Identify issues around the successful implementation of a canal development at each of the locations including land acquisition, rights of way, maintenance etc and outline solutions
- 4. Identify signage points
- 5. Provide details, including technical specifications, of the proposed developments and an estimated cost of each development
- 6. Clarify and confirm match funding arrangements for each location.
- 7. Investigate the feasibility of engaging with a GB or EU partner and, if positive, to identify a suitable partner
- 8. Provide an Action Plan, delivery methodology and timetable for implementation.
- 9. Consultation should take place with NIEA, Rivers Agency, Waterways Ireland, Land Owners & Local Authorities.

Section 2



URS Approach to the Assignment

On behalf of the three clusters, Armagh City & District Council URS have carried out the work specified below:

1.Identify at least one location in each of the three LAG areas for canal development

URS in consultation with the three clusters groups and Blackwater Regional Partnership agreed two key criteria for identifying areas for canal development which included:

- Land Ownership i.e. public or private
- Funding Criteria

2.Identify the most appropriate type of development for each location

URS carried out a site survey of each identified area to establish the most appropriate type of development for each LAG area. Within Northern Ireland the route of the Ulster Canal Largely remains within the SOAR area which only limited exposure to SWARD. Based on this Benburb Valley was identified as a key area for the SOAR area as it was currently within public ownership, ran parallel with the Ulster Canal and tourism infrastructure was already in place.

3.Identify issues around the successful implementation of a canal development at each of the locations including land acquisition, rights of way, maintenance etc and outline solutions

Typically funding restrictions and issues with land ownership are the initial criteria which determine a sites eligibility for further development. In URS experience the sites which are already in public ownership are suited to tourism development and fall within the criteria for types of funding streams

4. Identify signage points

URS sought to provide the minimal amount of signage points along each of the canal development areas. Positions for this have been established on the proposals seen in sections 8 to 10.

5. Provide details, including technical specifications, of the proposed developments and an estimated cost of each development

URS developed a palette of suggested materials which are influenced by similar type projects. This suite can be used as the basis for further detailed design.

6. Clarify and confirm match funding arrangements for each location.

This is covered in section of this report.



7.Investigate the feasibility of engaging with a GB or EU partner and, if positive, to identify a suitable partner

This is covered in section 13 of this report.

8. Provide an Action Plan, delivery methodology and timetable for implementation.

This is covered in the section 12 of this report.

9. Consultation should take place with NIEA, Rivers Agency, Waterways Ireland, Land Owners & Local Authorities.

The bulk of consultation has been held with the Ulster Canal Steering Group and Blackwater Regional Partnership Board. Sections 3 and 4 detail the rationale for site identification.




Ulster Canal Context

In order to carry out a focused series of consultations URS drafted a composite layout (refer overleaf) which provided a context to the Ulster Canal in relation to:

- Rural funding body boundaries
- Towns
- River Black Water
- · Historic Route of the Ulster Canal
- Remaining Sections of the Ulster Canal
- Waymarked Routes
- National Cycle Routes
- Disused Railway Line

The combination of factors would partly inform the identification of development sites which is considered in the next section.





Site Identification

Process

Following consultation with the Ulster Canal Steering Group and Blackwater Regional Partnership Board URS sought a steer on potential development sites.

All stakeholders agreed that in the context of this study any future development along the Ulster Canal should be based on a quick win basis.

In URS experience two essential criteria are key to the implementation of any scheme: Land Ownership & Funding.

For CM Leader area the canal Route from Monaghan to Tyholland was suggested by CM Leader representatives as a potential site for development (this route of the canal has been subject to a compulsory purchase order – it is now assumed that this falls under public ownership)

For the SOAR area the canal route along Benburb Valley was suggested by SOAR Representatives as a potential site for review (this land is in public ownership)

For the SWARD area several sites were considered but the historic route of the canal mainly falls outside SWARD boundaries. The view from SWARD was that future development should be based on developing access to the River Blackwater and this would manifest itself by developing stopping points along the river such as Blackwater Town, The Moy & The Argory. Unfortunately the height of the motorway bridge spanning River Blackwater at Verner's Bridge restricts larger craft navigating from Lough Neagh down the River Blackwater.

Based on all of the above URS carried out site surveys of each proposed site.
